Sarcomas are rare and highly aggressive cancers of the connective tissue such as bones, muscles, or soft tissue. Tumors can develop anywhere in the body at any age. Sarcomas are among the most common cancers in children. These cancers are commonly misdiagnosed, which contributes to a bleak 50% survival rate.

Rein in Sarcoma is a local non-profit organization with their main objectives: support sarcoma patients & their loved ones, educate the medical community and general public about sarcoma, and raise funds for sarcoma research.
