Rein in Sarcoma (RIS) is a Twin Cities based 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to:

- educating the public and medical community about sarcoma cancers
- supporting sarcoma patients and their loved ones
- funding research directed toward developing new treatments and finding a cure

Sarcoma is a rare type of cancer that starts in soft tissues or bones. It occurs in all ages and all areas of the body. In fact, sarcomas make up approximately 15% of cancers affecting children and young adults. Since 2001 RIS has funded nearly \$2.5 million for sarcoma research projects.
